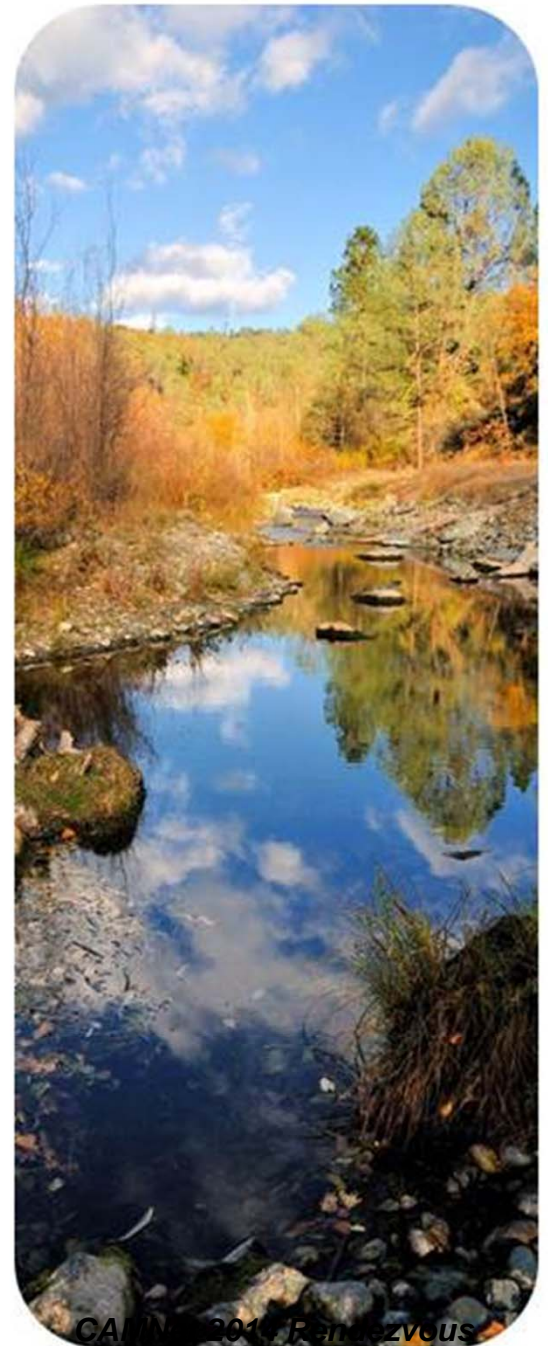

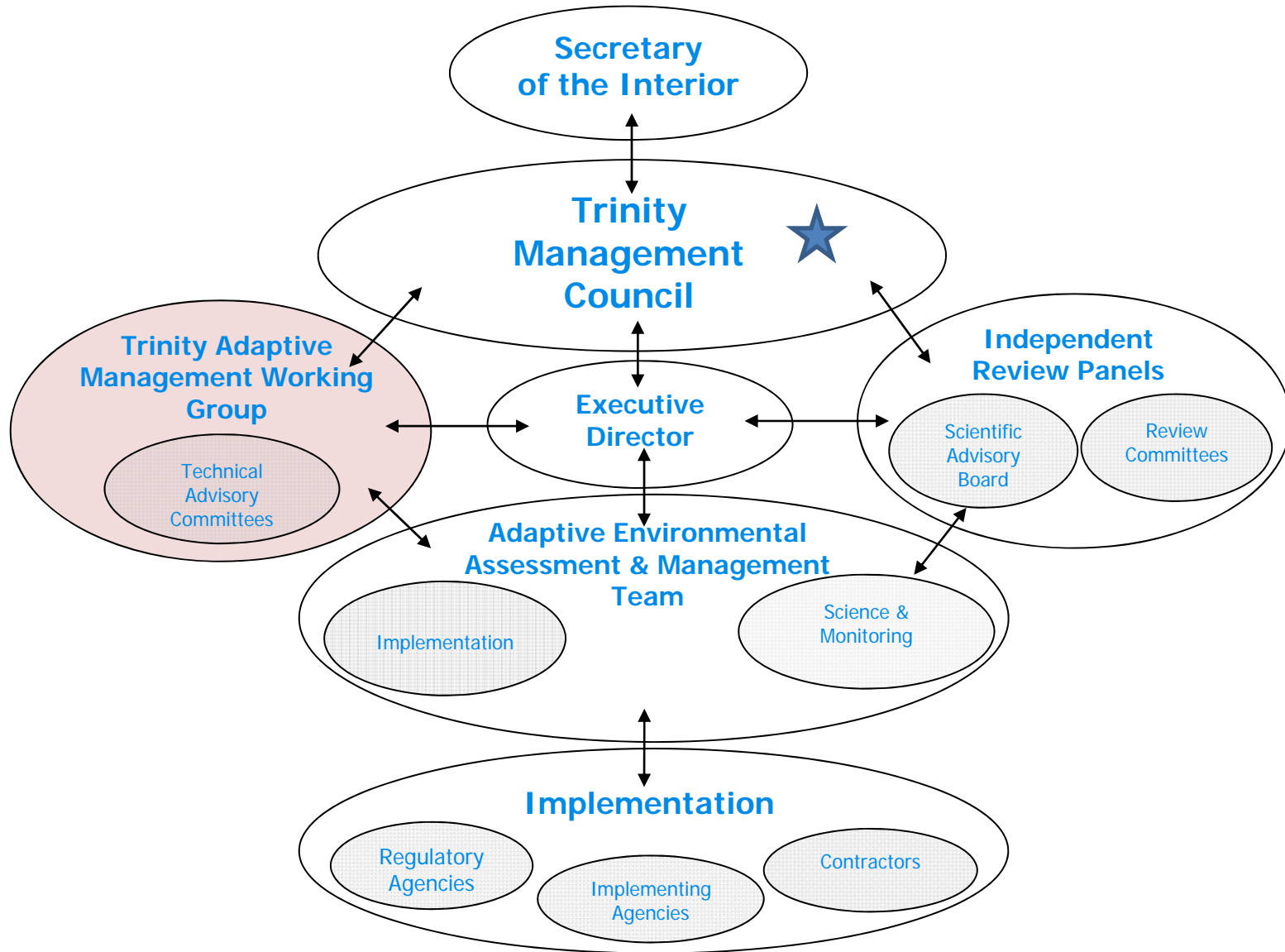

Position in the TRRP



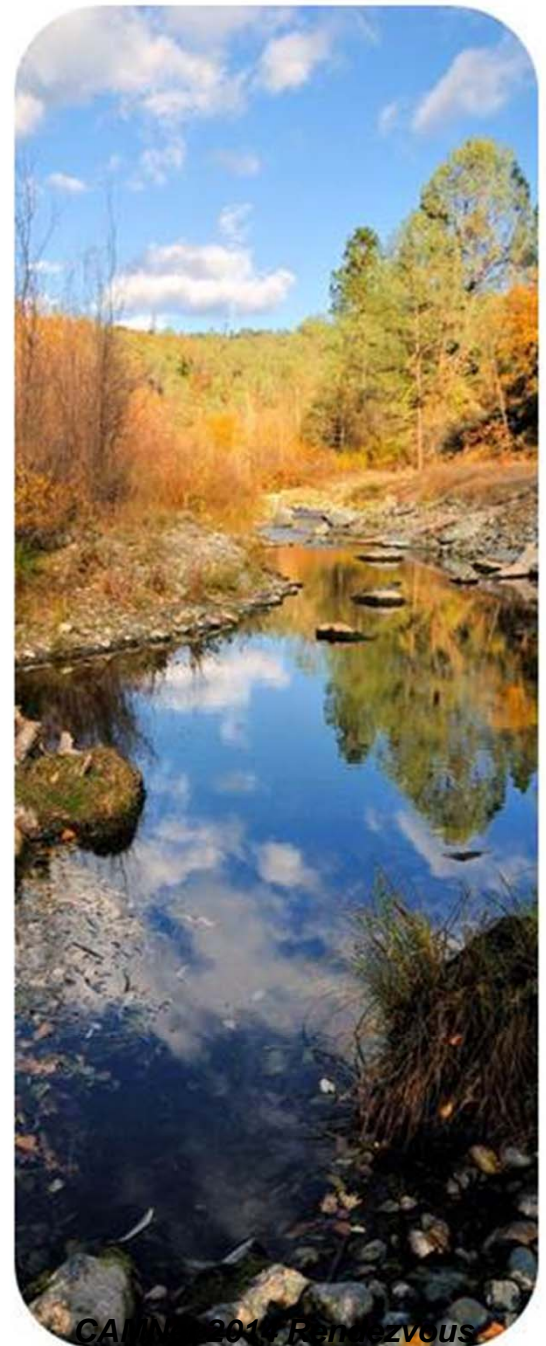
TAMWG

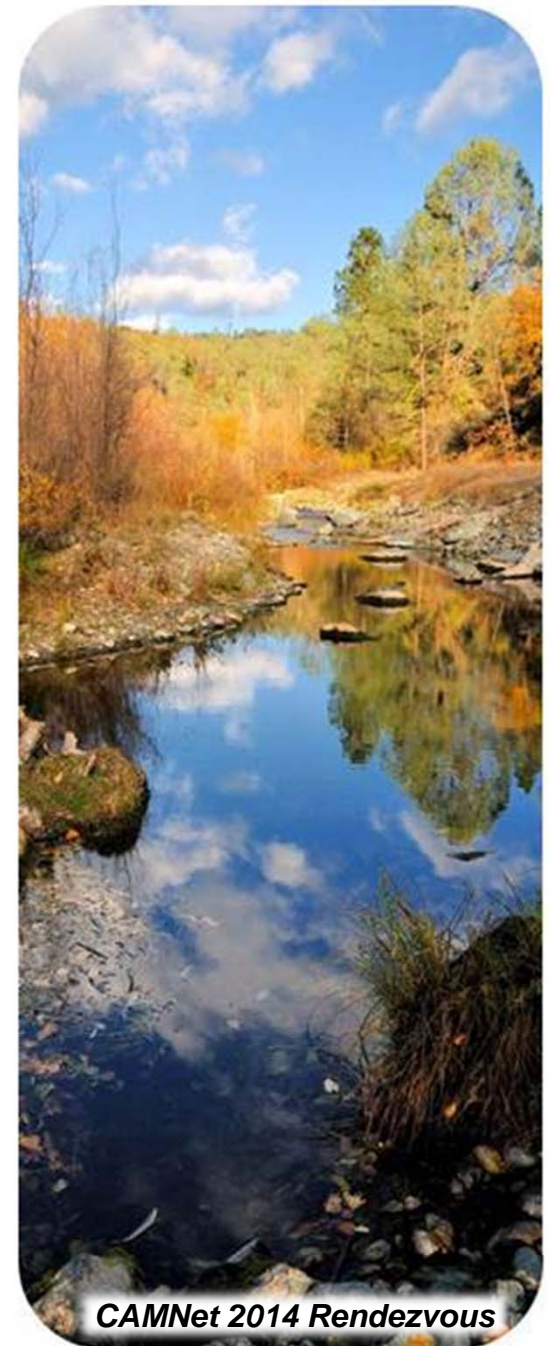

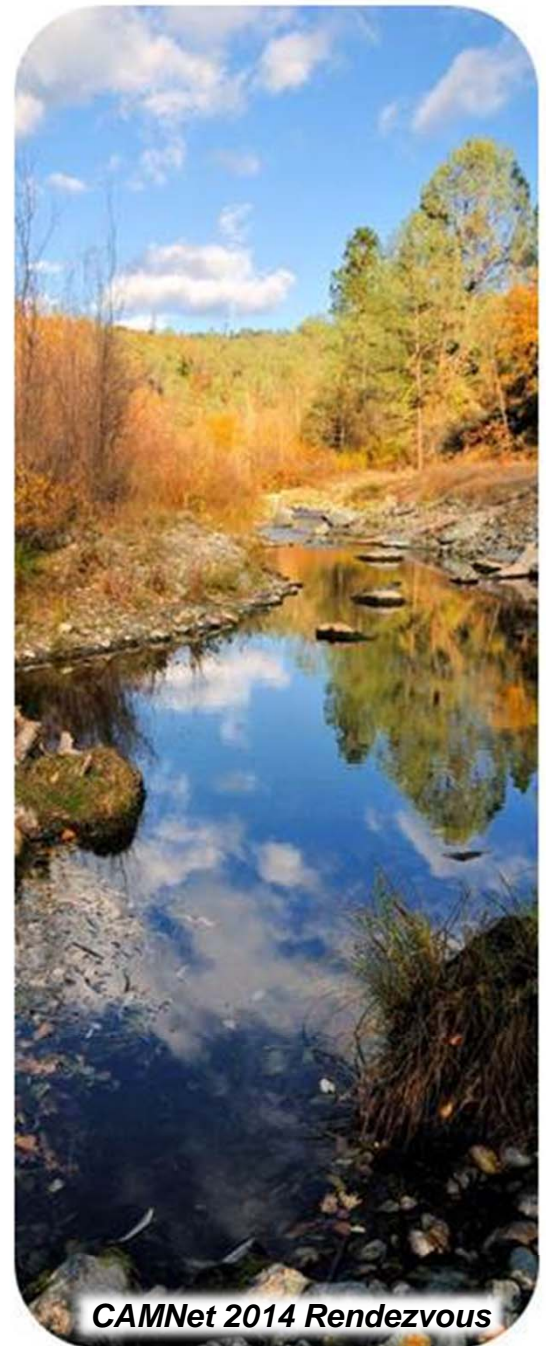
TAMWG Role

4. Other components of the TRRP



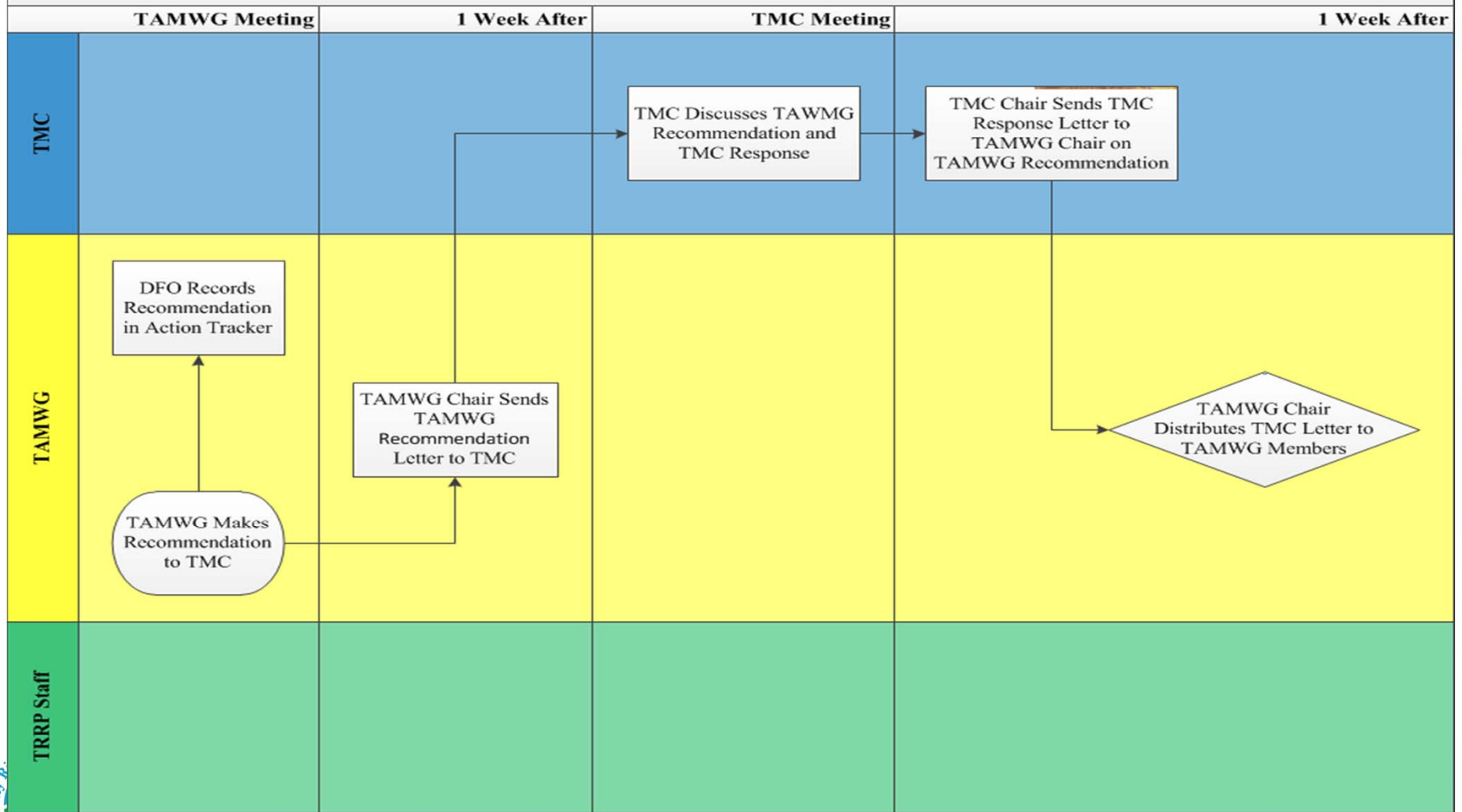

TAMWG lacks true authority

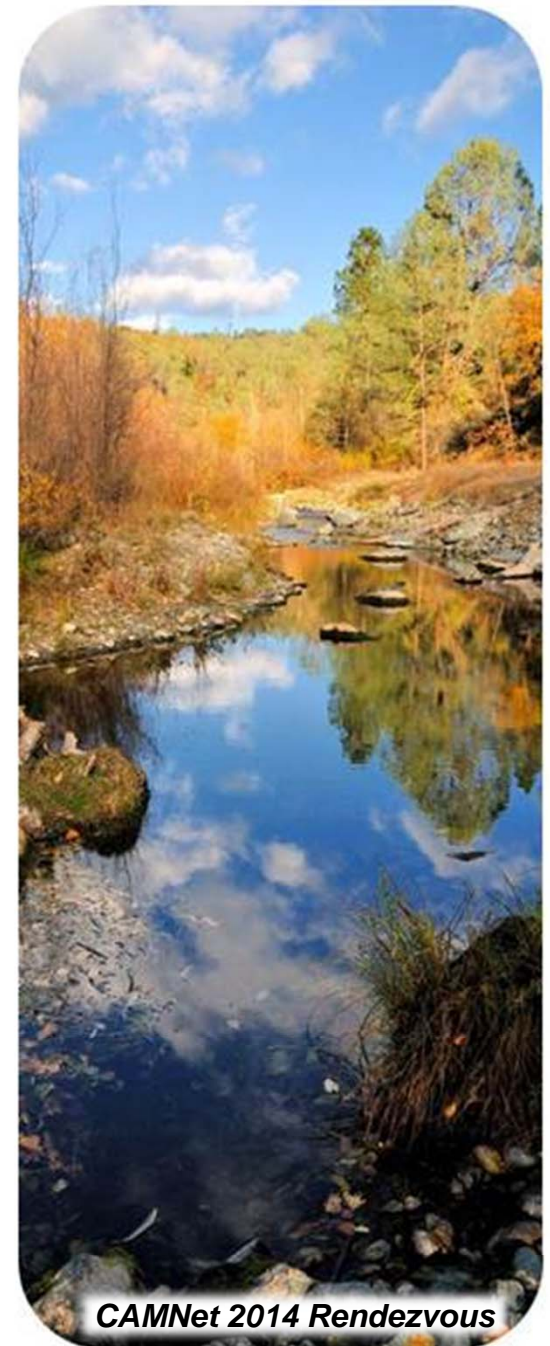
- TAMWG's Recommendations aren't always adopted by the TMC
